AMEA's Claussen Receives Public Service Award

In recognition of his longstanding commitment and contributions to public power, Alabama Municipal Electric Authority President and Chief Executive Officer Robert Claussen recently was presented with the Electric Cities of Alabama Public Service Award.

Electric Cities Executive Director Fred Clark presented Claussen with the prestigious award during the association's annual meeting in July. The Public Service Award is given each year to an individual who has contributed significantly to the success of Electric Cities and continues to work for the success of public power.
