Dothan's Paul Lee Elected to AMEA Board of Directors

Dothan City Commissioner Paul W. Lee is the newest member of the Alabama Municipal Electric Authority's Board of Directors. Lee was elected to the board by the AMEA Elections Committee during its recent meeting in Montgomery.

Lee's election to the board follows the retirement of longtime board member Don Clements of Dothan. Clements, who was first elected to the AMEA board in 1986, served the last four years as chairperson.

Commissioner Lee is a native of Dothan and represents Commission District 3. Lee graduated from Dothan High School and attended Wallace College. He has been employed with Sony since 1979. Lee's present position at Sony is Senior Production Specialist.

Commissioner Lee has served seven years on the Houston County Healthcare Authority for the Southeast Alabama Medical Center. He was Vice Chairman for four years.

Commissioner Lee has been married since 1981 to the former Ellen Vise of Dothan. They have a 12-year-old daughter, Beth. Lee and his family are active members at Southside Baptist Church where he serves as a deacon.

Commissioner Lee's term on the AMEA Board of Directors expires in August 2009.
